Cross-Country Leagues in the South West of England

Cross-country events cater for everyone, from 11 (sometimes younger) to over 70. Courses can be described as 'multi-terrain without the concrete', and vary widely from fast and grassy to stiff tests of endurance and sanity! The four cross-country leagues below form the backbone of cross-country running in the South West, but clubs also take part in the Hampshire and Birmingham Leagues, which are based just outside our region.

Cross-Country Leagues in the South West of England

Gloucestershire League

Attracts clubs from Gloucestershire, Avon and the West Midlands. There are four fixtures (three before and one after Christmas), all on Saturdays, and the series is decided on a 'best three out of four' basis.

Gwent League

Despite its name, this large league attracts clubs along the M4 corridor from Bath to Swansea, and some from further afield. There are five fixtures (three before Christmas, and two after), held on a mix of Saturdays and Sundays, all of which count towards overall positions.

Wessex League

This league is based in the centre and east of the region, attracting clubs from Somerset, Wiltshire, Dorset and Hampshire. There are four fixtures, all held on Sundays.

Westward League
